

Public Consultation Proposed Assessment Report for the St. Clair Region Source Protection Area

You are invited to read and comment on the Proposed Assessment Report for the St. Clair Region Source Protection Area

The posting of the Proposed Assessment Report is an important step in developing a drinking water source protection plan for the St. Clair Region Source Protection Area (SCRSPA). The Proposed Assessment Report is a result of revisions based on comments received from the posting of the Draft Proposed Assessment Report for the SCRSPA. Included in this Source Protection Area are the municipal water systems of the Lambton Area Water Supply System, Petrolia Water Treatment Plant and the Wallaceburg Water Treatment Plant. The Proposed Assessment Report was prepared under the Clean Water Act 2006 for the Thames-Sydenham and Region Source Protection Region.

The St. Clair Region Source Protection Area Assessment Report includes:

- the identification of vulnerable areas associated with municipal drinking water sources
- the types of activities which would be considered threats in those vulnerable areas
- any water quality issues associated with the raw (untreated) water to municipal drinking water systems which could be addressed through source protection planning
- a water budget which assesses areas where the quantity of water available for the municipal drinking water source may be stressed
- general background material which might be useful in developing a Source Protection Plan
