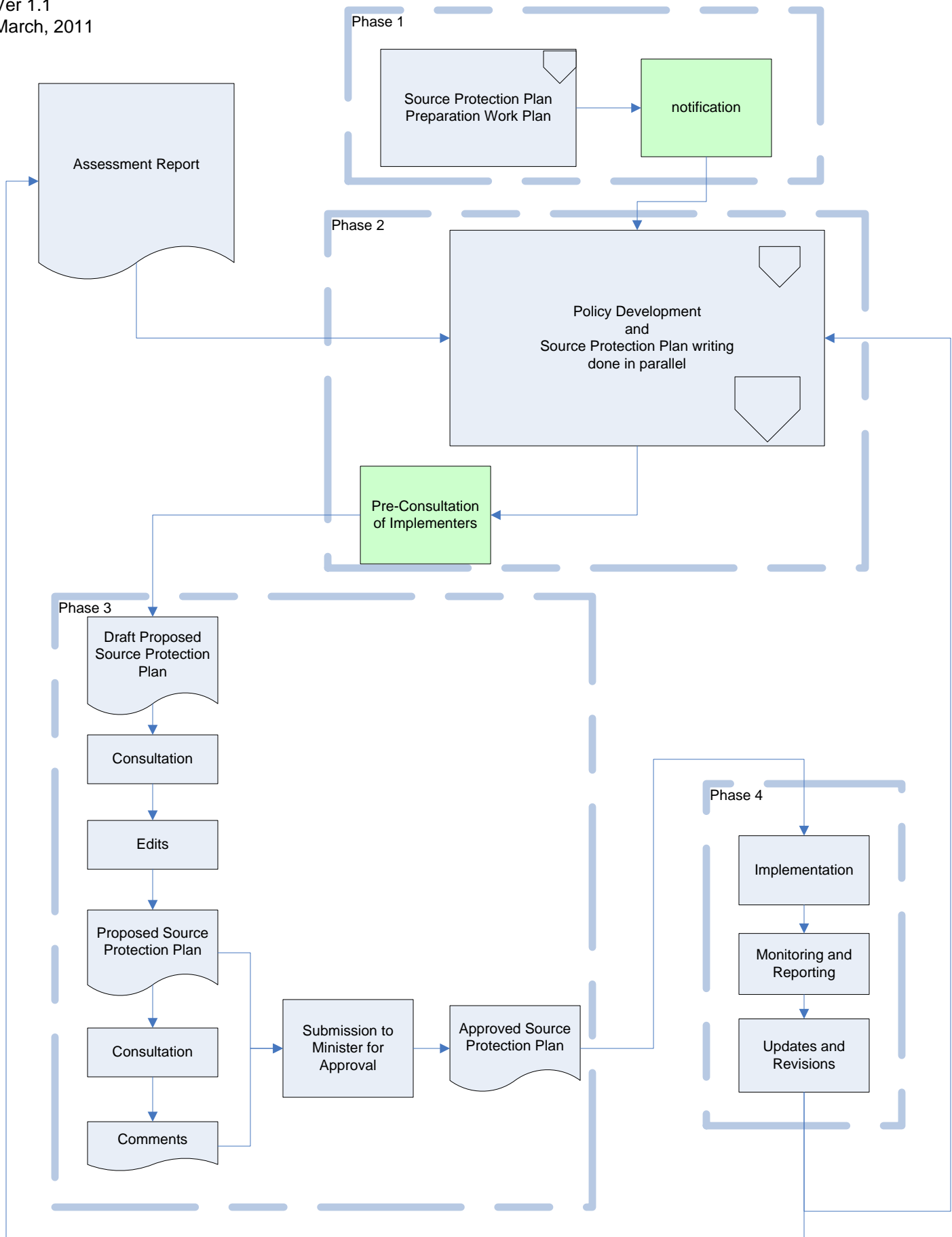
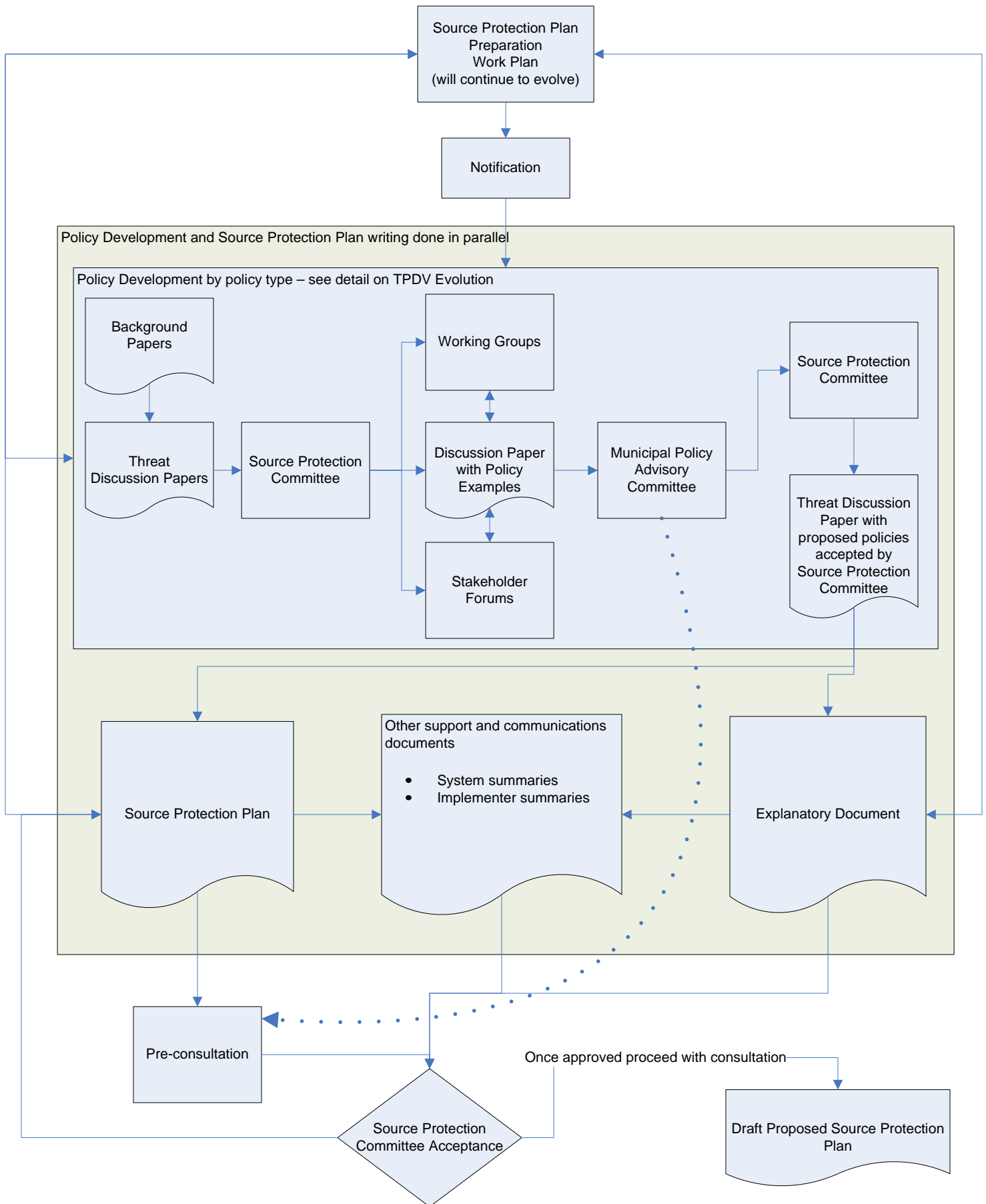

# The Evolution of Threat Policy Discussion Papers

- Proposed Policy Ideas

- Sample Policy Options (with examples for consideration)

The following is an illustration of the evolution of the TPDP as they are developed and improved. The starting point for the TPDP are a series of Background Documents developed provincially by the SPPAC working groups.
