Source Protection Terms of Reference Municipal Forums

The Thames-Sydenham and Region Source Protection Committee has been formed and has initiated its first major task: to create Terms of Reference for the 3 Source Protection Areas in the Thames-Sydenham and Region.

These Terms of Reference will act as a road map for the next 5 years for the completion of the Assessment Reports and the Source Protection Plans for the Source Protection Region. The Terms of Reference lays out what needs to be done, when, by whom and how much it will cost. The proposed Terms of Reference are required to be submitted to the Source Protection Authority by August 20, 2008.

Three forums are being hosted to explore opportunities for municipalities to:

- become involved in the Source Protection Planning Process, including participating in the development of Municipal Working Groups, and
- to identify the decisions that municipalities need to consider and council resolutions that will be required soon.

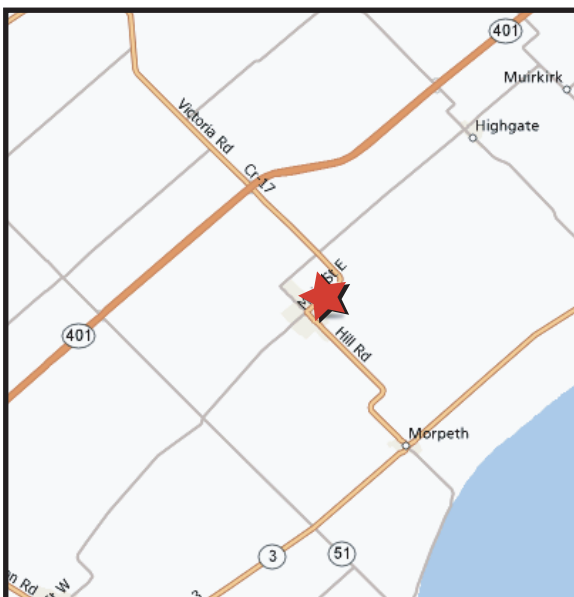
