June 21 @ Point Pelee Provincial Park

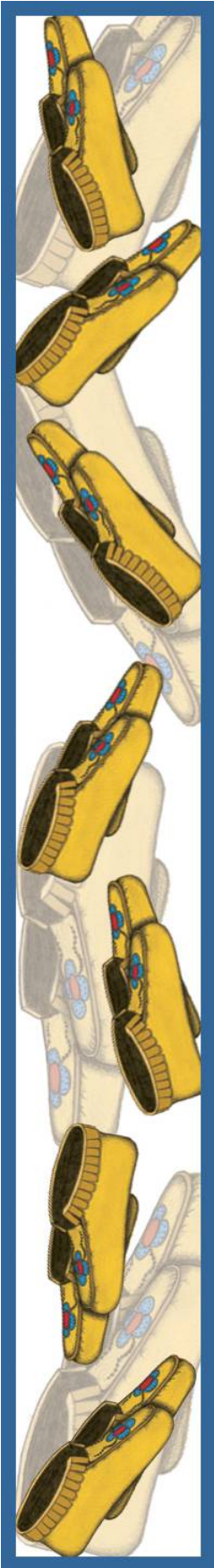
Organized by the Southern First Nations Secretariat at request of the Park.
